Welcome and Introduction

Welcome to our Café service either here in Church, online or reading at home. It is good that we can come together to Worship God: Today we will be looking at "COMMUNICATION" How do we communicate? Communication is important which avenues do we use? How does God communicate with us and how do we communicate God to other people?

Call to Worship: Psalm 145:1-13

I will extol you, my God and King, and bless your name forever and ever. Every day I will bless you, and praise your name forever and ever. Great is the Lord, and greatly to be praised; his greatness is unsearchable. One generation shall laud your works to another and shall declare your mighty acts. Readings: (God communicating) Exodus 3:1-6:

Moses was keeping the flock of his father-in-law Jethro, the priest of Midian; he led his flock beyond the wilderness, and came to Horeb, the mountain of God. There the angel of the Lord appeared to him in a flame of fire out of a bush; he looked and the bush was blazing, yet it was not consumed. Then Moses said, "I must turn aside and look at this great sight, and see why the bush is not burned up." When the Lord saw that he had turned aside to see, God called him out of the bush, "Moses, Moses!" and he said, "Here I am." Then he said, "Come no closer! Remove the sandals from your feet, for the place on which you are standing is holy ground." He said further, "I am the God of your father, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob." And Moses hid his face, for he was afraid to look at God.

Matthew 3:13-17:

Then Jesus came from Galilee to John at the Jordan, to be baptized by him. John would have prevented him saying, "I need to be baptized by you, and do you come to me?" But Jesus answered him, "Let it be now, for it is proper for us in this way to fulfil all righteousness." Then he consented. And when Jesus had been baptized, just as he came up from the water, suddenly the heavens were opened to him and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and alighting on him. And a voice from heaven said, "This is my Son, the Beloved. With whom I am well pleased.

Reflection:

Our two readings are just two of the ways in which God communicated with people and I am sure you could give your own examples from the Bible. In the two readings there is no

doubt as to what God was saying, what his message was. I want us to look at the various ways in which we now communicate with other people. As we, not only, see on the screen but others that spring to mind, especially if you are of a certain age before the advent of modern technology! However, here is where we can run into some difficulty when various abbreviations are used which, over the years have become altered meanings. Today we are bombarded by so many means of communication that we can be confused as to which is which. Using language or illustration is OK as long as the people it is aimed at are on the same wavelength if not then the whole message can be misinterpreted one such occurrence springs to mind from my own experience: I saw the following headlines in a Newspaper: **"Flames burn Oilers – Oilers Extinguish Flames.** What do you think this referred to?

This leads us to think about how we communicate with God – thankfully he will be on the same wavelength but more importantly at times how do we communicate God's message to us to other people, are we using the right means, the right technology etc to ensure that the message is relayed. We have the answer in how we can communicate with Jesus Christ as our next hymn tells us:
